Georgios Papazisis is Associate Professor of Basic and Clinical Pharmacology at the Department of Clinical Pharmacology, School of Medicine Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in Greece. Dr Papazisis is the Medical Director of the Clinical Trial Unit of the Special Unit for Biomedical Research and Education School of Medicine at the Papageorgiou Hospital <https://www.subre.auth.gr/en/home/>.



He is a specialized Psychiatrist and has also obtained the Greek Medical board certification for the medical subspecialty of Clinical Pharmacology. In 2018 he completed the pharmacovigilance training course at the Uppsala Monitoring Centre, the WHO collaborating Centre for international drug monitoring. Clinical trials, pharmacovigilance (psychotropic drug safety, vaccine safety and patient's safety), neuropsychopharmacology and pharmacoepidemiology are his fields of interest.

He was recently the principal investigator for Greece in two projects:

Dr. Papazisis is the Treasurer of the Greek Society of Pharmacology and Clinical Pharmacology and member of the 'Evidence Based Psychiatry' section of the World Psychiatric Association.
